



Belgian embassy in Tashkent – Internship opportunity

We are looking for an enthusiastic intern to assist with the opening (as of 1/9/2026) of the Belgian Embassy in Tashkent.

An ideal candidate has fluency in English, Russian and Uzbek. Knowledge of at least one of Belgium's languages (Dutch, French and German) is a plus. The duration of the internship is preferably at least 3 months, as of 1/9/2026.

An internship at the Embassy of Belgium in Tashkent offers a unique opportunity to gain experience in an international environment. Internships are unpaid, and the trainee is responsible for covering the expenses related to insurance, travel and accommodation. The internship must be part of an academic program or must at least be approved by the candidate's institution of higher education.

You will participate in the following activities:

- Assist with the administrative and logistical set-up of the new Belgian embassy;
- Draft reports and background notes on issues of interest (Uzbek policies regarding foreign affairs, domestic affairs, ...);
- Participate in meetings, conferences, and seminars with a variety of stakeholders (embassies, think tanks, policymakers, ...). Help organize such meetings for the Embassy;
- Contribute to the public diplomacy goals of the Embassy.

Required qualifications:

- Ongoing studies in a related field (e.g. international business, international relations, law, political science, oriental languages, etc.);
- Excellent writing skills;
- Good knowledge of Belgium is a plus;
- Have a sense of initiative and teamwork;
- Organizational skills and multitasking ability;
- Discretion and reliability.

Application requirements:

Your application must include:

- A resume and motivational cover letter;
- A letter of recommendation to be signed by a representative of your educational institution.
